

POPCORN MACHINE OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS:

*Please Note: DO NOT COVER THE AIR VENT HOLES: The motor air intake and exhaust holes at top of machine must remain clear of any obstructions.

*Please Note: AVOID BURNS: DO NOT TOUCH KETTLE WHILE HOT!

Switches:

Kettle Motor Switch: Turns on the motor that drives the kettle agitator shaft.

Kettle Heat Switch: Turns on the heat element inside the kettle.

Pop!

- 1. Turn on the kettle heat and kettle motor switch.
- 2. *Test pop a kettle of corn first: Place oil in kettle with (3) kernels- when kernels pop place the remainder of oil, measured corn and flavoring into kettle and close lid and door.
- 3. When the corn has popped empty the kettle **immediately** and return the kettle to the upright position.
- 4. *A normal popping cycle will take about two minutes and thirty-five seconds to three minutes and fifteen seconds. *
- 5. Repeat the cycle- loading kernel and oil pouch **immediately.** Always pop 3-5 batches for best results. Subsequent batches are always more flavorful than the initial batch.
- 6. Failure to empty the kettle immediately and reload immediately will cause strain on the thermostat and burn bottom of kettle.
- 7. When popping the last batch, turn off the kettle heat switch about midway through cycle.
- 8. Corn will continue to pop rapidly as there is plenty of heat left in the kettle.
- 9. When finished, make sure all switches are turned off.
- 10. Let the machine cool completely before moving.
